Set in the heart of the Pacific Flyway in Veteran's Park and downtown Klamath Falls, the Arts on the Flyway Festival is *Where Arts and Music Take Flight!* The AOTF planning committee has created an art and music festival that embraces all the beauty that Klamath Falls has to offer. Our family-friendly, art festival is located in historic downtown Klamath Falls, Oregon – a city that embraces public art and the great outdoors every day with our Pelicans on Parade, bird boxes, countless murals, Sugarman's Corner pocket park and gorgeous historic buildings. Our festival is a ½ mile loop including juried artisan and crafter vendors; nonprofits hosting interactive arts stations; delicious culinary arts in the form of food carts, tasting garden and a beer garden; and live performances of music, dance and theatrical performers. Plein air artists, art demonstrations and civic art projects will also be sprinkled throughout the festival that encompasses local art centers (The Favell Museum and the Klamath Art Association Gallery).

General Information

The Arts Festival can accommodate up to 100 fine artists and craftspeople from around the country. Artists offer work in a wide variety of juried

mediums including painting, ceramics, glass, jewelry, wood, photography, fiber, metal and more.

Free performances by regional acts will be presented on three stages. This Arts Festival hosts at least 3,000 people from Klamath, Jackson, Josephine, and Siskiyou counties. We are dedicated to providing you, the exhibiting artist, the support needed to experience an enjoyable and profitable weekend.

FOOD VENDOR INFORMATION:

The number of food booths are limited, so that all vendors can have fair trade while offering a wide selection. AOTF food vendor fees are \$75. Vendor fee submission is due at time of application. Submission fees are not processed unless the applicant is accepted, at which time applicant will be notified.

NOTE: You must fill in your needs for electricity and provide all trailer information on the application; failure to provide the correct information may result in revocation of the vendor's application to participate and forfeiture of vendor fee once accepted. Electric hook-up is an additional \$25 fee.

Food Vendors must comply with Klamath County Public Health Department and Klamath County Fire District regulations. Representatives from these agencies may conduct inspections of the vending sites. The vendor is solely responsible for following any and all regulations pertaining to their activity.

Clean Up: All participants must dispose of trash in bins and receptacles and sweep their area. No liquid of any kind shall be disposed in street gutters, storm drains or catch basins. Participants will be held responsible for any damage to city or business property.

GENERAL FESTIVAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

IMPORTANT NOTES - No Exceptions to the following

- Absolutely **no pets** of any kind are allowed on the Festival grounds; only dogs which are "service animals" will be permitted.
- No smoking anywhere in the park, it is prohibited; a city ordinance.
- Absolutely no camping, dry or wet, is allowed on the festival grounds.
- Non-alcoholic beverages may not be served in cups with alcoholic logos or vice versa.
- Music in booths should be used with discretion as to not disturb other vendors or live performances.
- No opening late or closing early options during the festival.
- No vehicles on the festival grounds.
- No generators (special considerations made case-by-case)
- No alcohol.

Booth Information

- There is a non-refundable application fee of \$10 upon your submission.
- Booth fees are \$50 for a 10x10 single booth or \$75 for a 10x20 double booth. Electric hook-up is limited and an additional \$25. **Deadline for all applications is August 24, 2017.**
- Cancellation and Withdrawal: AOTF Charges a \$25 fee for vendor cancellation. No refunds are issued after September 15, 2018
- Sales Tax: There is no sales tax in Oregon.
- Vendors are not to begin set-up until Saturday 9/22/18 beginning at 9am. Absolutely no set up sooner. Set up must be completed by 11am sharp Saturday.
- No vehicles allowed on the grass areas within the Booth areas of the park.
- Vendors are required to remain open and available for Arts Festival patrons until the 4pm closing on Saturday, no exceptions.
