JURY DETAILS:

All arts and crafts items **MUST** be hand-made or created by the vendor. Entries will be judged on artistic quality, creativity, design and craftsmanship by the Arts on the Flyway committee. The committee is judging your work on the images you submit, so please keep this in mind while documenting your work and booth for your application.

Four photos of sample artwork and 1 photo of your booth setup are required with every application; no exceptions. Photos will not be returned. Only jpg images accepted with online applications. Be aware that the clarity and quality of your images will have an impact on whether or not the work is juried into the Festival. Here is how you need to save your images: Last name_01.jpg

Submission fees are not processed unless the applicant is accepted, at which time the applicant is notified.

ALL artwork **MUST** be handcrafted by the submitting artist; no commercially manufactured artwork is allowed. Only juried artwork is permitted in the artist vendor booth; this will be enforced by visual inspection via the Festival committee throughout the weekend; vendors who do not comply with this risk being dismissed from grounds.

Our festival is a ½ mile loop including juried artisan and crafter vendors; nonprofits hosting interactive arts stations; delicious culinary arts in the form of food carts, tasting garden and a beer garden; and live performances of music, dance and theatrical performers. Plein air artists, art demonstrations and civic art projects will also be sprinkled throughout the festival that encompasses local art centers (The Favell Museum and the Klamath Art Association Gallery).

General Information

The Arts Festival can accommodate up to 100 fine artists and craftspeople from around the country. Artists offer work in a wide variety of juried mediums including painting, ceramics, glass, jewelry, wood, photography, fiber, metal and more.

Free performances by regional acts will be presented on three stages. This Arts Festival hosts at least 3,000 people from Klamath, Jackson, Josephine, and Siskiyou counties. We are dedicated to providing you, the exhibiting artist, the support needed to experience an enjoyable and profitable weekend.

Rules/Regulations

Only works of art created by the artist juried in as an exhibitor at the Summer Arts Festival may be displayed or offered for sale. All work exhibited must be hand-crafted, original and produced by the vendor artist.

Reproductions are allowed, but content/image/object must be original work made by artist/vendor. Only work in the medium category(s) into which the artist is juried may be shown and sold. Work must be comparable in size, scope, style and quality to the work that was pictured in photos submitted for jury.

The artist guarantees the authenticity and the accuracy of the descriptions of the works presented. Works beyond the scope or medium represented by slides or photos originally submitted for the jury process will be prohibited from exhibition. For example, an artist accepted in the medium category of ceramics would not be allowed to also exhibit jewelry, unless both were juried in and accepted in advance.

Exhibitor's name, logo, biographical information and business cards may be displayed, as well as information about gallery representation. No other cards, ribbons, catalogues, brochures, fliers, posters or publicity materials (that are not related to the artist or the artist's juried works) may be displayed.

Arts on the Flyway Festival committee members will be conducting daily rounds to view artist booths to ensure that all the artwork on display during the festival has been juried into the event and handmade by the individual artist. This assures each artist vendor of the AOTF Festival meets the quality standards that all expect.

Artists may not let or sublet their booths either entirely or partially, with or without charge. Work of individuals other than those juried and accepted and specified in the artist's application for entry may not be exhibited or advertised in the booth. By doing this the exhibiting artist risks forfeiting participation in the Festival.

GENERAL FESTIVAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

IMPORTANT NOTES - No Exceptions to the following

- Absolutely **no pets** of any kind are allowed on the Festival grounds; only dogs which are "service animals" will be permitted.
- No smoking anywhere in the park, it is prohibited; a city ordinance.
- Absolutely no camping, dry or wet, is allowed on the festival grounds.
- Only artwork media juried in at time of acceptance is allowed in your booth.
- All artwork must be the artist's handmade work only.
- Artist must be present in booth.
- Music or audio in booths should be used with discretion as to not disturb other vendors or live performances.
- No opening late or closing early options during the festival.
- No vehicles on the festival grounds.
- No generators.
- No alcohol.

Booth Information

- There is a non-refundable application fee of \$10 upon your submission.
{NOTE: Returning artists/crafters may have the juried process waived if product has not changed in nature, quality or general price point.}

- Booth fees are \$50 for a 10x10 single booth or \$75 for a 10x20 double booth. Electric hook-up is limited and an additional \$25. **Deadline for all applications is August 24, 2017.**
- Cancellation and Withdrawal: AOTF Charges a \$25 fee for vendor cancellation. No refunds are issued after September 15, 2018
- Sales Tax: There is no sales tax in Oregon.
- Art vendors are not to begin set-up until Saturday 9/22/17 beginning at 9am. Absolutely no set up sooner. Set up must be completed by 11am sharp Saturday.
- No vehicles allowed on the grass areas within the Artist Booth areas of the park.
- Artist vendor booths are required to remain open and available for Arts Festival patrons until the 4pm closing on Saturday, no exceptions.
- Each booth space accommodates a 10 feet deep by 10 feet wide booth tent. Double booths accommodate two tents, 10 feet x 20 feet.
- Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own booth structures with canopies, racks, chairs, tables, display units or other fixtures suitable for outdoor use.
- Artists are encouraged to make their work in front of the attendees, within their booths. Be prepared for any inclement weather with appropriate rain covers, tie-downs and weights etc. Direct sun can be a factor as well, since most booths are in direct sun or only partial shade.
- If you are interested in demonstrating your craft, please submit a demo schedule with your application.
